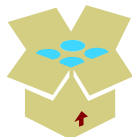

Extra copies of original materials from the church vault and many old printers' blocks are free for the taking. Thanks to our member shortbread bakers.

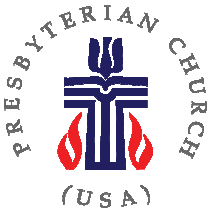


### Prayer Chain Phone Tree
